The Councillors were pleased to see a healthy bank balance but keen to stress how much of the budget was committed to ongoing projects, including the Traffic Calming Scheme, purchase of the marquee for the recreation ground/pavilion and the environmental survey of St. Andrew's churchyard.

Description Douglas Fir x 1 Fell - The Douglas Fir is 40 years old and has been found to be dying. The tree is in close proximity to a native sycamore and it is not intended to replace the Douglas Fir.

- 7. To hear reports from other meetings. None reported.
- 8. To discuss correspondence and any other business.
 - NFDC Waste Strategy the councillors applauded the effects of NFDC to increase recycling in the district. However, there were safety concerns that in some Rockbourne properties, without pavements and on narrow parts of the road, wheelie bins would be totally impractical. There was also a lack signposting in the strategy to other local recycling initiatives that cover material not recycled by NFDC. The strategy did not address the number of visitors to the district and concerns were expressed by the councillors that a reduction of bins in public areas would increase incidences of litter. It was felt that the Waste Strategy should also give recognition and capacity for significant additional packaging created by on-line purchase activity.

Action: Cllr Kirkcaldy to speak to Head Mistress at Rockbourne School re: recycling shed.

- Census 2021 the councillors were aware that the census was imminent and if called upon would be willing to lend any assistance.
- County Council Rural Broadband Scheme councillors were keen to explore this scheme further and asked the Clerk to investigate.
 Action: Clerk to report to Parish Councillors on potential options/benefits.
- Valuation Office Agency Club House & Sports Ground Cllr Kirkcaldy reported that due to an error on the part of the VOA an invoice had been sent to the Parish Council for the rateable value of the Recreation Pavilion. This error was due to an incorrect address being listed for the pavilion and VOA not acknowledging the pavilion as being run by a charity. Cllr Kirkcaldy phoned the VOA to inform them of the correct details.
- Annual Playground inspection councillors asked the Clerk to organise inspection in readiness for spring.

Action: Clerk to organise inspection.

 12th edition of Arnold-Baker on Local Council Administration – councillors agreed to purchase a copy. Cllr Kirkcaldy proposed. Cllr Broadbridge seconded. Action: Clerk to purchase copy.

- Remembrance Sunday: the Parish Councillors discussed the Royal British Legion criteria for public parades and memorial events at the War Memorial in the village. The Councillors decided that Rockbourne Parish Council should not, in future, organise any Remembrance Sunday events. These events will be organised by private individuals instead, who are prepared to accept full liability.
