Proposed Works: T1 Sycamore – Fell/ T2 Hazel - Reduce to hedge height/ T3 - Beech reduce crown by 2-3m to previous pruning points. T4&T5Yew Reduce by up to 5m to reduce the sail affect.

Reason for Work: T1 Sycamore - Fell because of cases of Atypical Myopathy locally due to Sycamore. There are horses kept within the adjoining field and paddock. The tree would have been selfseeded. The tree would not have an impact on the local amenity value if it wasn't there. T2 Hazel - Reduce to hedge height, this is suitable management to limit the

size of the tree. T3 - Beech reduce crown by 2-3m to previous pruning points. This is suitable tree management to limit the size of the tree.
T4 & T5 Yew - Reduce by up to 5m to reduce the sail affect. Some of the branches have recently split and gone towards the road.
