Planning comment sent 15/3/22. This application appears to adhere to all the necessary regulations relating to installation of Wood burning stoves. Rockbourne Parish Council recommend Par 3 on safety grounds, raising the Chimney will reduce the risk of falling embers onto the Thatch.
