Banknotes & Coins; Postcards (GB/foreign, posted & unused) - supporting Leprosy Mission An international Christian development organisation that diagnoses, treats and offers specialist care, including reconstructive surgery, to leprosy patients.

All other items accepted for recycling

- Batteries (household only)
- Cheese packaging (all brands of flexible plastic packaging and nets. No wax)
- Contact lens blister packaging, soft contact lenses, old glasses
- Corks (natural cork only)
- Crisp/snack packaging (flattened)
- Dental plastic (clean toothbrushes, toothpaste tubes)
- Elastic bands (return to the school)
- Foil (must be scrunchable and washed)
- Keys
- Make-up packaging (compacts, tubs, pots, lipsticks, lip balm, mascara. No glass bottles, eye pencils, brushes, nail varnish or aerosols)
- Medicine blister packs (Must be completely empty of all medicines!)
- Tetra Pak cartons (rinsed and flattened)
- Plastic can ring loops
- Writing instruments (Pens, felt tips, highlighters/markets, correct fluid pots, mechanical pens and eraser pens. No pencils or chalk)
